2010 Dues Structure

There are 5 classes of membership

● **Class A** : Non-Profit association/
Individual=\$90.00

Class B: Home based businesses=
\$100.00

Class C : Agriculture Producers =
\$160.00

Class D: Store Front Businesses=
\$230.00/year base + \$10.00/full time employees, or \$5.00/part time employees (under 25 employees)

Class E: Major Employers= \$250.00/
year base + \$15.00/full time, \$10.00/
part time (greater than 25 employees).
